
# Venue



#### Main venue: CIEMAT



- Address: CIEMAT, Moncloa Center. Avda. Complutense, 40 28040 (Madrid)
- The centre is located at the very end of the university campus (Ciudad Universitaria).
- Please note that to access the centre you need to show your ID at the security point where you will be given a guest card and a map of the facilities of the centre.








#### **About CIEMAT**

With a team of 1,300 people, CIEMAT is technologically and geographically diversified.






# **Arriving to Madrid Barajas airport**

CONFECT

- Madrid-Barajas was awarded the best Airport in Europe, according to AirHelp Score 2023, and 12th worldwide.
- No taxes payable nor arrival/departure.
- More than 70 countries with 176 direct international connections.
- Only 15 km away from the city, is among the world's most accessible in terms of ease and speed.



# **Arriving to Atocha train station**



- The main Madrid train station is called Atocha, and it is managed by the public company Renfe Operadora.
- It is the busiest station in Spain, servicing over 110 million travellers per year.
- It is so big that it has two names:
  - Madrid-Puerta de Atocha includes high-speed AVE and Media Distancia train lines.
  - Madrid-Atocha Cercanías includes Cercanías, local commuter lines.
- The Atocha train station is located on the southeast of the city centre, on Glorieta Carlos V.



# How to get to the venue?



#### By car

- CIEMAT has its own free car parking.
- From Moncloa: Arco de Triunfo, Avda. Arco de la Victoria (A6), Plza. de Cardenal Cisneros y Avda. Complutense.
- From M-30: exit Sinesio
   Delgado, direction Ciudad
   Universitaria-CIEMAT.
- From Barajas Airport: lies 12 km of the city centre.



# How to get to the venue?

# CONFECT

#### Metro

- From the Barajas airport: Metro Line 8 "Barajas-Aeropuerto". Please note that there are two different stops, one from terminals T1-2-3 and another for T4. The terminals are also connected by shuttle service.
  - For reaching CIEMAT from the airport, use line 8 and stop at "Nuevos Ministerios" station in order to get the line 6 towards Ciudad Universitaria station.
  - Once reached the Ciudad Universitaria metro station, follow the <u>information linked here to</u> <u>reach CIEMAT.</u>

#### Bus

- From Moncloa: Line 82: Paraninfo-CIEMAT stop.
   The starting point of the bus line is at Meléndez Valdés, 72.
- From Moncloa: Lines G and U (from Moncloa), which stop at Paraninfo-Telecomunicaciones.



#### Metro + Bus

- From Atocha Station:
  - Metro line 1 to "Metro Cuatro Caminos" station.
  - Once reached this station, it is a short walk to "Cuatro Caminos" bus stop to take line F bus to Paraninfo—Informática. See full details here.
